Installation of new Portland stone has been completed on the hotel side and continues at roof level.

The internal fit out of the Hotel guestrooms is proceeding to plan.

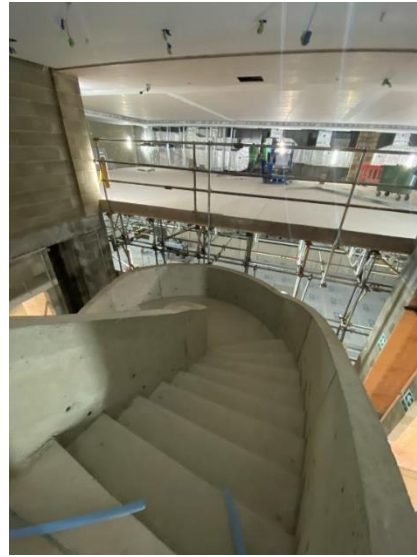
Fit Out of the 85 residential apartments is proceeding to plan.

Work is proceeding to plan to fit out of the Hotel Spa.

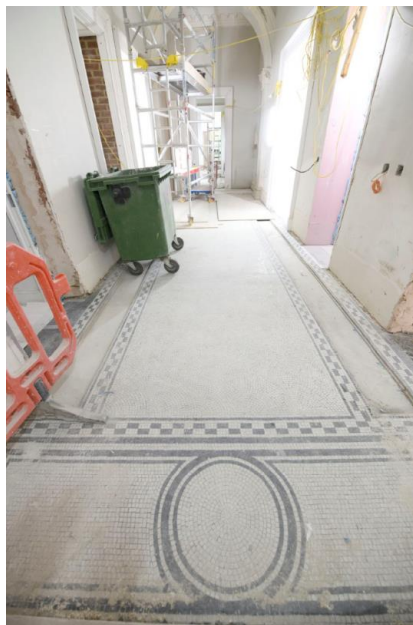
